Know all men by these presents that I James McKinney of the State and District aforesaid for and in consideration of the Natural Love and affection which I bear unto my Daughter Lucinda Saylor of the State and District aforesaid and also for the consideration of One Dollar to me in hand paid by my Daughter Lucinda at and before the sealing and delivering hereof the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge hath given granted bargained and sold and by these presents do give grant bargain and sell unto my Daughter Lucinda Saylor the following Tract or parcel of Land to wit &c Tract No 1 Known as the Wilson Barton Tract containing Two Hundred acres be the same more or less situate lying and being in the State and District aforesaid on the waters of South Syger River bounded by lands of Herbert Hawkins William Bates and others. Tract No 2 Known as the Wilson Goodlett Tract on the State Road containing One Hundred and forty acres be the same more or less situate lying and being in the State and District aforesaid on the waters of South Syger River bounded by Lands of William McKinney Jr No 3 Dickey and others Tract No 3. Known as the Wilson Goodlett upper Tract containing Two Hundred and forty acres be the same more or less situate lying and being in the State and District aforesaid on the waters of South Syger River bounded by Lands of Alexander McKinney No 3 Dickey and others Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises hereby given and executed unto the s^d Lucinda Saylor my Daughter her and her bodily heirs for ever above named property to continue mine during my Natural Life Time
