 for my self my heirs executors administrators do
 warrant & defend the aforesaid goods & chattels unto
 the said W M Lenderman his heirs executors admin-
 istrators & assigns against my self & against all
 persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same
 Nevertheless upon condition that if I the said
 Josiah J Shall & do well & truly pay or cause to be
 paid unto the said W M Lenderman his executors
 administrators or assigns a certain Note under
 Seal of One Hundred Dollars & forty one cents bearing
 date the 16th day of July One Thousand eight hundred
 & Sixty one payable to the said W M Lenderman
 or order & due one day after date to gather with
 all the interest that may accrue thereon according
 to the full intent and meaning of the same
 then these presents to be void & of none effect
 and until default is made in the payment of
 the Note above mentioned and described according
 to the meaning & intent thereof I the said Josiah
 J Pollard am to have peaceable possession of the
 goods & chattels aforesaid. In testimony whereof
