that I W^m H^c Harrison for and in consideration of the love and affection I have for my grand son John H^c Harrison have given granted and released unto the said John H^c Harrison a certain piece of land lying in the State and district aforesaid to contain twenty five acres more or less beginning on a Sweet gum and running with G^o W^m H^c Harrison's line to a Stake on the gap creek road thence running up the road to a Stone corner then a straight line to a Lower wood on the side of the mountain then a straight line to a red oak corner then a straight line to the beginning Sweet gum corner with all the rights members hereditaments and all appurtenances thereto belonging and by these presents do grant and release unto the said John H^c Harrison his heirs and assigns and I do hereby bind myself my heirs administrators executors and assigns to warrant and forever defend the above mentioned premises to the s^d of W^m H^c Harrison his heirs and assigns forever.
