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Executors of John J Coleman deceased by virtue of a power to us given by the last will and testament of the said John J Coleman of Greenville District in the aforesaid State in consideration of the sum of nine Hundred Dollars lawful money of the United States to us paid by Charles H Judson of Greenville District in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said C H Judson all that lot and parcel of land situate in Greenville District and State aforesaid containing Twenty four and One half acres known and described as follows "beginning at a stake in the center of a street 70 Ft wide opened from the Augusta road through the lands of the estate of the late J. J. Coleman being the corner of the lot sold to Prof J. C. Edwards and thence running S 83 E 22.20 chs to a stone corner thence N 1 E along the land of H R Williams 13.76 chains to a stone corner on the street leading to Hammonds mill, thence along said street N 82 3/4 W 10.26 chains to a h oak thence N 89 W 11.91 to the center of the first mentioned street, thence along said street S 1 W 9.70 to the place of beginning and having such shapes as the plat herunto annexed represents." Together with all and singular the rights Members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said C H Judson his heirs and assigns forever. And we do hereby bind our selves as Executors aforesaid our heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said C H Judson his heirs and assigns against our selves and our heirs and against all other person lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof."
