To warrant and forever defend the above described land for the use & purpose before mentioned unto the S^d Eleanor Shelton from us or our heirs or assigns for ever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof In witness whereof we have set our hands hereunto affixed our seals this fourth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty Signed sealed in the presence of us
