Thence S 73 W 10 due to the beginning also one other tract adjoining the above containing 61 acres for a more particular description of which reference is hereby made for a plat of survey made by John Ellatson Esqr showing dated 14th Nov 1835 and to the deed for the same to John M Roberts to beed from his Executors to me. To have & to hold all and singular the premises together with the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to the said Emmeola Butler Jones and Elizabeth C Jones and the heirs of their body lawfully begotten & who shall be living at their death and in the event of the death of either of my said grand daughters leaving no issue living at their death the portion of such one so dying shall go to the survivor or the child or children of such survivor so living as aforesaid. Provided nevertheless that I the said Waddy Thompson shall at all times have the power & the same is hereby retained by me to sell or dispose of all or any portion of the premises above described and to invest the proceeds for the benefit of my said grand children and that at my death another trustee shall be appointed by the consent with authority to hold the said premises in trust for my said grand daughters as this paper is intended as a declaration of said trust & to protect the premises from the contracts or engagements of any future husband of either of my said grand children.
