 do hereby certify unto all whom it may concern that Mary Ann Barton the wife of Benjamin F Barton did this day appear before me and upon being privately and seperately examined by me did declare that she does freely Voluntarily and without any compulsion dread or fear of any person or persons whomsoever renounce release and forever Relinquish unto Manerva Flemming her heirs and assigns all her interest and estate and ^{also} all her right and claim of Dower of in or to all and singular the premises hereafter Descrbed described it being part of a tract of land granted to John Russell and part of a tract granted to Thomas Barton and part of a tract granted to Andrew McCray and Jesse Davis and was sold by Sarah McCray the widow of Andrew McCray Deceased agreeably to his will and was bought by Benjamin F Barton and Baylis W Fleming and they divided the land and after the death of the said Baylis W Fleming the said Benjamin F Barton and Manerva Fleming the widow of Baylis W Fleming made relinquishment to each other agreeably to the way they had divided it. Now the part that she relinquishes her claim of dower is the part that her husband relinquished unto the said Manerva Fleming
