and inconsideration of the natural love and affection which I have and bear unto my grand son Anderson Griffith and also in consideration of the sum of Five dollars to me in hand paid by the said Anderson Griffith at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have given aliened and confirmed and by these presents do give alien and confirm unto the said Anderson Griffith his heirs and assigns the following personal property. Viz, One horse Saddle and bridle, One cow and calf, One sow and pigs, One killing hog, One rifle gun, One bedstead, bed and bedding, and one third part of my growing crop. No part of the above gift to be consummated until after my death but should I die before the present growing crop is gathered, then and in that case the above deed is to be carried into effect and no sooner. To have and to hold all and singular the above named property by these presents as given aliened and conveyed unto the only proper use and behoof of the said Anderson Griffith his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever, and I the said William Griffith for my self my Executors administrators shall and will warrant and forever defend all and singular the the said property mentioned in the foregoing part of this Deed unto the said Anderson Griffith his Executors administrators and assigns against me and my heirs executors & administrators and against all and every person or persons whomsoever claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. I do authorize my Executors or administrators to carry into effect this deed and to deliver the said property to the said Anderson Griffith after my death
