South Carolina 3 know all Greenville District 3 men by these presents that I Reuben Sally 271

of Greenville District in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of sum of Eleven hundred and fifty two dollars to me paid by William McKinney in the State aforesaid have granted bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said William McKinney a tract or parcel of land lying and being on the east side of the road leading from the town of Greenville S.C. to the town of Ashville N.C. and about fifteen miles from the former town, and being in the District of Greenville S.C. containing three hundred and thirty nine acres more or less being a part of a tract of land that was heretofore conveyed by Thomas Edwards to Jere Wilcox and by Jere Wilcox to Samuel H. Wilcox and that was afterwards sold as the property of said Samuel H. Wilcox by Nimrod Underwood then Sheriff of Greenville District aforesaid to William H. Gilliland and conveyed to him by deed bearing date the 9th of November 1825 and recorded in the office of Register of Mease County once for Greenville District S.C. at pag. 50 of Book P which contains a full description of the said premises. and conveyed by said William H. Gilliland to Reuben Sally of said State and District bounded as follows, viz, beginning on a Red Oak corner on the west side of the Ashville Road thence N 39 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 19.50 ch to a Rock & thence N 54 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 47 ch to Rock & thence S 83 W 10.45 ch to a Red Oak & thence N 6 W 33.40 ch to a Hickory & thence West 21.20 ch to a Stake & thence S 80 W 1.50 ch to a Stake & thence S 43 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 46.60 ch to a Rock & thence S 57 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 7.33 ch to a small Hickory & thence S 45 $\frac{1}{4}$ W 7.92 ch to a Red oak & on the Ashville road, thence down the road to the beginning corner together with all and singular the rights members hereditam onto to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William McKinney his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my self my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said William McKinney his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and again every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the
