Charleston in the State aforesaid, accountant, for and
in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand five hundred
Dollars to me paid by Julius C Smith in the State aforesaid
have granted bargained sold and released and by these
presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the
said Julius C Smith a certain Lat of Land lying and
being in the Village of Greenville and State aforesaid being
part of a Lat of Land formerly owned by John D Powell conveyed
by him to J H Glenn from said Glenn to Moses McCrary from
Moses McCrary to Charles Merrick and from Charles Merrick
to me the said Wm B Heriot on the 14th day of September
A D 1861 Beginning at a Stake at the lower end of the Lat
owned by J S McDaniels thence down Church Street to the
corner of Avenue Street and Church Street thence along
Avenue Street three hundred feet to the corner of Avenue
Street and Mordica Street thence up said Mordica Street
One Hundred and thirty four feet to a Rock of J S McDaniels
corner thence along J S McDaniels line to beginning corner
and aforesaid Stake. Together with all and singular the
rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said
premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining
I have and to hold all and singular the premises before
mentioned unto the said Julius C Smith his heirs
and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind my self my
heirs ~~executors~~ and administrators to warrant and forever
defend all and singular the said premises unto the said
Julius C Smith his heirs and assigns against me and my
heirs and all and every person and persons whomsoever
lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
