Know all men by these presents that we Thomas Gower Thomas M Cox and Henry C Markely partners composing the firm of Gower Cox & Markely in the State aforesaid & District Greenville for and in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred Dollars to us paid by Alexander W Black of the District of Greenville in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Alexander W Black all that piece parcel and Lot of Land containing One Acre One rood and thirty three perches more or less situate lying & being in the corporate limits of the town of Greenville S.C. and hath boundaries as follows beginning at a stake corner of lot now owned by A W Black on the Anderson Road and running with said road S 30^o W 68 feet to a bend in the road thence S 15^o W 140 feet to a street fifty feet wide thence S 78¹/₂ E 313 feet to a stake thence N 26¹/₄ E 180 feet to a stake corner of lot belonging to A W Black thence N 73¹/₂ W 330 feet to the beginning corner. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Alexander W Black his heirs and assigns forever and we do hereby bind our selves our heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Alexander W Black his heirs and assigns against us and our heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness our hands and seals this Nineteenth day of September in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty two and in the second year of the sovereignty & Independence of the Confederate States of America, signed sealed & delivered in the presence of
