Know all men by these presents that I Mary Taylor of the District & State aforesaid for & in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred & Eighty dollars to me in hand paid by Alexander McKinney of the District & State aforesaid have granted bargained sold & released & by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the said Alexander McKinney a certain tract or parcel of land situate & being in the District & State aforesaid on the south side of the State road including the place where Milton Compton now lives begining at a stone 3+ in the center of the State road & runs with said road N $\frac{1}{4}$ E 14.14 to a stone 3+ on William McKinneys line thence with said line S $\frac{1}{4}$ W 10.26 to a stone 3+ thence S $\frac{1}{4}$ E 10.11 to the begining containing five acres two rods & 28 poles more or less together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise appertaining to have & to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said Alexander McKinney his heirs and assigns for ever. and I do hereby bind my self my heirs executors
