Know all men by these presents that I William C Trowbridge of the said State and District aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred and Ninety six dollars and twenty five cents to me paid by Thomas Hopkins of the said State and District aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Thomas Hopkins a Tract of one hundred and twenty two and a half acres of Land more or less situate lying and being in the District of Greenville and State aforesaid on the head branches of the South Kedy Fork of Kedy River and being composed of Two tracts adjoining each other One containing One Hundred three and a half acres bounded as follows. Beginning at a white oak 3+ thence S 4 W 50 chs to a Hickory 3+ thence S 85 E 20 chs to a white oak 3+ thence N 5 E 50 chs to a Stake 3+ thence N 85 W 12 50 chs to the beginning corner. The other tract contains Nineteen acres and is bounded as follows. beginning at a Stake 3+ N 5 E 42 chs to a Stake 3+ thence N 63 W 10 chs to a Pine 3+ thence S 6 E 47.25 chs to the beginning corner. both tracts containing One Hundred and twenty two and a half acres more or less and bounded by lands of Mrs Jane Moon Jasiah Chandler Drury Hopkins and Artemus Holmitch Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the premises belonging to or in anywise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said Thomas Hopkins his heirs and assigns forever and I William C Trowbridge do hereby bind my self my heirs executors assigns administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Thomas Hopkins his heirs and assigns against my self and my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this the 30<sup>th</sup> of September in the
