I know all men by these presents
that I Doct W Riley Jones of
Greenville District State aforesaid for and in consideration of the
sum of Four thousand two hundred and fifty dollars (\$4250)
to me paid by Samuel Mc Green of Greenville District State
aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released unto the
said Samuel Mc Green all that piece parcel and lot of Land situate
lying and being in the Town of Greenville in the District and State
aforesaid containing twenty four thousand Square feet more or less
and bounded as follows. Viz. Two hundred feet on Coffe Street on
the North One hundred and twenty feet on Richard Street on the
west Two hundred feet on Lot land owned by Estate Job Mauldin
on the South and one hundred and twenty feet on Laurens Street
on the East Conveyed to me by Perry C Duncan and Charles J
Elford Executors of the last will and Testament of Sabey Gilreath
on the second day of July AD 1855. Together with all and singular
the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the
said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining
to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned
unto the said Samuel Mc Green his heirs and assigns forever
and I do hereby bind my self my heirs executors and administrators
to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises
unto the said Samuel Mc Green his heirs and assigns against
me and my heirs and against every other person whomsoever
lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
Witness my hand and seal this Twenty first day of May in the
year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty
two and in the eighty sixth year of the Independence of the State
of South Carolina
