thence N 21 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 2.56 chains to a white oak $\frac{3}{4}$ thence East 10.00
chains to a R. O $\frac{3}{4}$ thence N 44 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 6.94 to R. O thence S 56 W 17.00
chains to a pile of Stones $\frac{3}{4}$ thence N 41 W 12.80 to a slate $\frac{3}{4}$
thence S 61 $\frac{1}{4}$ W 4.25 chains to the Creek thence down the Creek 21.40
chains to the mouth of the branch thence up the branch 8.70 chains
