that I Archiebald Vaughn of the

State and Dist aforesaid have for the sum of twelve hundred
Dollars to me in hand paid by L B Austin of the State and
Dist aforesaid have agreed to go as a substitute for the said
L B Austin who has belonged to Co F Hamptons Legion S.C.
Since August 1861 The said money I have invested in a tract
or parcel of Land lying in the State and District aforesaid
on the branch of the waters of Gilder Spring land of Pinkney
Vaughn & H. Atkinson Bramlett and the balance of the original
tract of land called the Lock place one hundred acres more
or less being the land I this day bat of that Walker includ-
ing the house in which he now lives called the Lock place
if I am not rec'd in the Legion as a substitute for the said L
B Austin he is to pay me one dollar per day while gone also
my expenses there and back, and fifty dollars, and I am to
give him up the said land together with the rights and
titles I now hold for the said land also my wifes dower
Witness my hand and seal this the 10th day of Nov 1864

or parcel of land situated in Greenville District of this State on
the Rutherford and Chick Spring Roads, containing one hundred
and fifty acres more or less adjoining lands of Miles Lauthen
and others and more particularly described in a deed from the
said Miles Lauthen to me the said Eliza Clary dated the 19th
day of July A.D 1861 and recorded in the office of the Clerk of
the Court for Greenville District in Book 3 on page 177 &
