Know all men by these presents  
that of William P Pool of Green  
ville District in the aforesaid

State in consideration of Fifteen Hundred Dollars to me  
paid by W A Jennings of Greenville District in the State  
aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and  
by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto  
the said W A Jennings all that tract or parcel of Land  
situate and being in Greenville District and State aforesaid  
on a branch of Maple Creek of Reedy River Beginning at a  
Stone 3 + 4 Rens \$33 6 19.50 to a Stone 3 + thence N 67 1/2 E 34.20 to a  
Stone 3 + thence N 25 W 17.25 to a Stone 3 + thence N 65 E 25.00 to a  
Red oak 3 + dead and down thence N 13 W 3.60 to a Stone 3 + thence  
S 65 1/4 W 19.75 to a Post oak 3 + 3 + thence S 66 1/4 W 36.00 to the beginning  
but no Land on the East side of the Laurens Road is hereby  
conveyed and said Land is conveyed to said Jennings to the  
Laurens Road and no further containing Sixty Seven acres  
more or less it being part of a tract of Land originally gran-  
ted George Underwood the 7<sup>th</sup> day of August 1786

Together with all and singular the rights members hereditament  
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise  
incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular  
the premises before mentioned unto the said W A Jennings and  
to his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self  
and my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and  
forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the  
said W A Jennings and to his heirs and assigns against me  
and my heirs and every other person lawfully claiming or to  
claim the same or any part thereof

Witness my hand and seal this 31<sup>st</sup> day of March in the year of our  
Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty three and in the 87<sup>th</sup> year  
of the Sovereignty and Independence of the State of South Carolina
