

in the State of South Carolina and received her letters
of guardianship accordingly for and over the personal estate
of the aforesaid Richard Thruston who is a minor under
the age of choice, and thirty she the said Susan W Thruston
become entitled to receive the share of the said Richard Thruston
in the said estate of Lewis S Thruston deceased. And wheras
no division of the said estate hath been as yet made, and it
is desirous that such a division shall now be made so that
each party entitled might receive and take in severally their
respective interests in said estate and also that the Executor
and Executrix aforesaid might finally settle and wind up the
estate of the said Lewis S Thruston, this agreement. In partite
is to day the twenty second day of April AD 1862 made between
the aforesaid Alexander McBee of the first part Susan W Thrus-
ton guardian of Richard Thruston of the second part and
Susan W Thruston Executrix and Robert T Thruston Executor
of the last will and testament of Henry L Thruston Executor
of Lewis S Thruston deceased, of the third part and witnesseth
that the aforesaid parties of the first and second part by and
with the consent and understanding of the party of the
third part do herewith divide partition and allot to the
other party respectively the said estate of Lewis S Thruston
deceased and each respectively alleins release and quits
claim to the other parts as aforesaid their respective rights
and claims in and to the property so let a part allotted
and partitioned to the other party respectively to wit the
aforesaid Alexander McBee of the first part takes as the share
of the said estate to which he is entitled a negro woman slave
named Betty and her two children to wit Linda and George
for and during the term of the life of Keenetta McBee wife of
the said Alexander McBee and a negro woman slave named
Maria and her two children named John and Jacob for and
during the term of the minority of the aforesaid Richard Thruston
and a receipt from the Executors of the aforesaid H Lee Thruston
for all demands which the estate of the said H Lee Thruston may
have against the aforesaid Keenetta McBee during her widow-
hood as Keenetta Thruston and also against the said Alexander
McBee for matters pertaining to the estate of said Lewis S Thruston
purchased or taken by the said Keenetta or furnished her and
part for by the said H Lee Thruston deceased. The aforesaid Susan
W Thruston guardian of Richard Thruston takes as the share of
her ward to which he is entitled in the estate of the said Lewis
S Thruston deceased the remainders in the said slaves above allotted
to Alexander McBee after the estate herein limited to her shall have
been terminated and a fee simple estate to a negro boy named
Tom Dick. and a note upon S W Thruston for thirty five \$35 dollars
dated the 30 day of Oct AD 1854 and one other note upon Mrs
Sarah E Deoyley for twenty four $\frac{98}{100}$ Dollars dated the 30th day of Oct
AD 1854 and the balance of the funds of the estate of Lewis S
Thruston deceased which may be found on hand at the final settlement
of said estate by the decree of the ordinary also the watch of the said
