William M Thomas Esquire Commissioner of the Honorable Court
of Equity for Greenville District at Greenville Court House in the said
State of the one part, and Chevis & Montgomery of the other part
Whereas Andrew J Green administrator of Zion Green deceased and
Mary Green widow of said deceased, on or about the eighth
day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and fifty six exhibited their bill of complaint in the court of Equity
at Greenville Court House in the said State against James W Green
et al teros for the partition of the lands of the said deceased and
for the payment of his debts, and the cause being at issue before
the Honorable court came on to be heard at July Term in the year
of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and fifty seven when the
said Court after full hearing thereof and mature deliberation in
the premises did order adjudge and decree that the land should
