And the cause being at issue before the honorable court came on to be heard at Chambers in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty three when the said court after full hearing thereof and mature deliberation in the premises did order adjudge and decree that said land should be sold at public auction by the commissioners of the said court, on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in their several orders as by reference thereto in the registry of the said court will appear, and the said William Mc Thomas as Commissioner of the said court after having duly advertised the said land for sale by Public outcry on the Fourth of May in the year of our Lord
