Now therefore this Indenture witnesseth that the said William M Thomas as Commissioner of the said Court under and by virtue of the said Decree and in consideration of the sum of three dollars paid him by the said Joseph Waldrop the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and release unto the said Joseph Waldrop and his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in Greenville District on the Gap Creek road containing two hundred and ten acres adjoining lands of Cleveland Bates and others and more particularly described in Book V on page 68 and 69. in office of Recorder of Mesne conveyance for Greenville District in a deed from D Hooke Sheriff of Greenville District to Harmon Waldrop. Together with all and singular the hereditaments rights members and appurtenances whatsoever to the said Land belonging or in anywise appertaining and the reversions and remainders rents issues and profits thereof, and also all the estate right title Interest down possession benefit claim and demand whatsoever, both at Law and Equity of the heirs and representatives of the said Harmon Waldrop and of the parties to this suit, and of all other persons rightfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof by from or under them or either of them, To have and to hold the said Land with its hereditaments privileges and appurtenances unto the said Joseph Waldrop and his heirs and assigns to his and their only proper use benefit and behoof forever
