 said husband in executing the within release and that the same
 was positively and bona fide executed at least seven days before
 this her examination, and that she did then and still does
 at this time freely voluntarily and without any manner of
 compulsion dread or fear of any person or persons whomsoever
 renounce release and forever relinquish unto the within named
 George W. Center his heirs and assigns all her estate interest
 and inheritance in all and singular the premises within mentioned
 and released

 or plantation of land lying on the waters of Tyger on Morgan
 Creek for and in consideration of the sum of Eighty Dollars
 to me in hand paid by the s.d. Joseph Burnell the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged to him his heirs Executors
 Administrators & assigns forever, Beginning on a flat Rock
 by W. P. Hart's Spring thence N 34° 42' W 08 Chs to Hickory thence
 thence S 84° W along a line Run for M. Lindsey now of Gosnell
 line to a Hickory thence S 9 10 50 E to 20 oak thence S 40 E 11 50
 E to a chestnut on the Bank of the creek thence down said
 creek 5 chs 50 lbs to the junction of the Cove Branch & thence
 up s.d. branch to the beginning corner by Estimation forty
 acres more or less unto the said Joseph Burnell his heirs &
 assigns forever I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors
 & Administrators to warrant & forever defend the said
 farm I cee unto the said Joseph Burnell his heirs &
 assigns forever against myself my heirs executors ad min
