Centers to a Rock thence running to George W. Centers Rock corner thence running with George W. Centers line to a pine knot corner, thence running the original line to the Ford of the river thence down the river to the mouth of the branch thence running up the branch to the mouth of a drain ditch thence up the ditch to Joseph McKinneys pine corner thence running Joseph McKinney line to a rock corner thence running with Joseph McKinneys to McKinneys pine corner thence a Strait line to the beginning corner conta- -ining forty four and three fourth acres be the same more or less and I do hereby bind my self, my heirs and assigns to warrant and forever defend the above described premises unto Alberny Ballenger and Sinsly Ballenger their heirs and assigns against any other person or persons lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof In witness whereof I have here unto set my hand and seal this 13 th day of August 1860 signed and delivred in presents } of B J Stewart Artemus Stewart } Jacob Bellew (L.S.) mak
