and sold as her property and conveyed to me by
the Sheriff of Greenville District a plat of the
same being henceunto annexed together with all and
singular the rights members headements and appurten-
ances to the said premises belonging or in anywise
incident or appertaining, to have and to hold all
and singular the premises before mentioned unto the
said James C Furman his heirs and assigns forever
and I do hereby bind my self my heirs executors and
administrators to warrant and forever defend all and
singular the said premises unto the said James C Furman
his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs lawfully
claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
