sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain
sell and release unto the said Lardner Gibbon all that piece
and parcel and tract of land containing five hundred
and ninety five acres more or less situate lying and being
in Greenville District in the State aforesaid upon the
waters of North and Middle Saluda Rivers adjoining
lands of Mays Foster Goodlett Cleaveland Prichard
and Witt and having the following lines metes and
bounds as laid down in a plat of the same made
