So Wit, Whereas by the last Will

and Testament of George Jones the Father of my wife, he gave her a portion of his Estate and intended to settle the same on her so that it could not be spent or sold by her husband & might be distributed amongst her children after her death, and Whereas then are great doubts whether this Settlement is valid in law & is sufficient to carry out the purposes & intentions of my said Father in Law in making his will & giving the said property to my wife and her children, and Whereas it is my wish and intended purpose that all the property real & personal which comes hereafter to come to my wife from her Fathers Estate should be settled on her and for her sole & separate use during her natural life & at her death to be equally divided amongst our children. Now therefore I know all men by these presents that I William B Thompson for and in consideration of the reasons above set forth & for the love & affection which I have for my wife and children & for the further consideration of Five dollars to me in hand paid by Alexander Mcbee Esqr of Greenville District have granted bargained sold & conveyed and by these presents do grant bargain sell & convey all my right title & interest in the following property Viz, a tract of land situate lying and being in Polk County North Carolina on white oak creek containing Two Hundred & Sixty acres more or less which was laid off for my wife by the County Court as a portion of her Fathers lands & which has ever since been in her possession, also the following slaves, Sam Scunda & her children Sam & her children Millie Bob & Neal and the future increase of the female slaves, likewise all other property of whatsoever kind it may be which my wife receives from her Father in his life time or from his estate since his death with the increase & profit of the same - and all interest which she may have in the Estate of her Mother Mrs Elizabeth Jones at her death as in the Estate of Father at the death of her mother. The said Alexander Mcbee to have & to hold all & singular the said Lands Slaves and other property to himself & his heirs in trust for the sole use & behalf & separate use of my wife Mary B Thompson during her natural life and at her death to be equally divided between our mutual
