District & State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of One thousand and dollars to me paid by Wm Howell of the State and District aforesaid I have bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Wm Howell a certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the District of Greenville on a small branch of Rocky creek waters of Enore River adjoining lands of J Ell Walker & King Baylis Smith J Vaughn and J Jones containing fifty acres be there more or less beginning on a stone & thence N 13³/₄ W 031.05 to a stone & the S 56³/₄ W 28.50 to a stake & S 59¹/₂ E 3.88 to a sp O. Stump the S 55¹/₂ E 6.35 to a Stake & the S 34 E 18.45 to R 03 & the N 75¹/₄ E 806 to the begining. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditament and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said W Howell his heirs and assigns and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said W Howell his heirs and assigns against my self my heirs and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
