 Peter G Gerard conveyed to George Patton and reference to
 in a plat of John Watson Surveyor dated August 24th 1833
 annexed to the Deed from G Croft to P G Gerard and sold under
 a foreclosure of Mortgage by J Hooker Sheriff of Greenville District to
 George Buist and by said George Buist to me on the seventh day
 of December Eighteen hundred and forty six. Together with all
 and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances
 to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or apper-
 taining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises
 before mentioned unto the said Otis Mills his heirs and
 assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs
 executors and administrators to warrant and forever
