to Rebecca Davis	For Land	

Know all men by these presents
that I Jesse Coval of the State and District aforesaid for and
in consideration of the sum of One hundred and twenty five
Dollars to me in hand paid by Rebecca Davis of the same
State and District have granted bargained sold and released
and conveyed unto the said Rebecca Davis a certain tract or
parcel of land situate in the State and District aforesaid
on a small branch of South Tyger River adjoining lands of
Loftis & others begining on a Chesnut corner running thence
a westerly course to a white oak on the branch thence down
said branch to Loftis line a fence thence along said fence a South
direction to a Stone corner thence on the same course with
the fence to a red oak bush corner thence through the old
field to the corner of the woods thence to a Stone corner
thence to the begining corner being a North course the same
