grant bargain sell unto the said W. B. Green a certain tract
or parcel of land situate and lying in the District and State
aforesaid on Mountain Creek, South Fork, on the west side
of the old Rutherford Road Beginning at a Post oak 3+ on the
side of the Road and runs thence North 88° 00' 3 chs 20 links
to a Stake, thence N 88° 00' 8 chs 18 links to Stake 3+ on thence
N 43° 4' 00' 37 chs 50 links to a White oak near a small branch, thence
S 75° E 11 chs to a Black Gum on the side of the road thence
to the beginning corner containing Forty two acres be the
same more or less, together with all and singular the said
premises with their appurtenances unto the said W. B. Green
his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself
and heirs to warrant and defend the same from myself and my
