 To For This indenture made the Fifth  
 P & C P Mayfield Land day of October in the year of our  
 Lord one thousand eight hundred and  
 Sixty three between William M Thomas Esquire, Commissioner of the honor-  
 able court of Equity for Greenville District at Greenville Court House in the  
 said State of the one part and Pleasant Mayfield and Charles P Mayfield  
 of the other part, Whereas Pleasant Mayfield et al on or about the  
 Fourteenth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight  
 hundred and Sixty three exhibited their bill of complaint in the  
 court of Equity at Greenville Court House in the said State against  
 Cora Mayfield et al representing all the heirs at Law of Daniel May-  
 field deceased for the partition of the Real Estate of said deceased  
 and the cause being at issue before the Honorable Court came on to be  
 heard at Chambers in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hund-  
 red and Sixty three when the said Court after full hearing thereof  
 and mature deliberation in the premises did order and judge and  
 Decree that said Real Estate should be sold at Public Auction by  
 the Commissioner of the said Court on the terms and for the purposes

 Charles P Mayfield the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath  
 granted bargained sold and released and by these presents doth grant  
 bargain sell and release unto the said Pleasant Mayfield and Charles  
 P Mayfield and their heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of  
 land Situate lying and being in Greenville District on Bollingers Creek  
 and branches of said Creek, Branch waters of Enore River commencing  
 at a Hickory 3+0 m down, Rock 3+0 m in place on the Indian Boundary  
 or Spartanburg line N 3 1/4 W 37.43 to Post oak 3+3+0 m N 81 3/4 W 20.64 to Rock  
 3+0 m S 72 W 6.67 to Rock 3+0 m N 87 1/4 W 10.50 to Poplar 3+0 m in place of a  
 Stake N 83 1/2 W 15.25 to a Rock 3+0 m in field in place of Dogwood 3+0 m on
