Mc Green purchased three fifths of a certain tract of land  
 of Joel E. Morris as will more fully appear by said Morris  
 deed to them bearing date the 21<sup>st</sup> day of December A.D. 1860, the  
 said tract of land containing three hundred acres more  
 or less and the said three fifths thereof being purchased  
 jointly by the said George N. Green and Willis Mc Green as  
 share and share alike, and whereas the said George N. Green  
 recently departed this life intestate and leaving no wife or  
 child or living descendant but leaving his father Darius  
 Green his two Brothers Willis Mc Green and James H. Green  
 and his two Sisters Elizabeth Ross wife of Jesse Ross and Nancy  
 M. Brown wife of Israel H. Brown as his only heirs and  
 distributees at law, and whereas James Franklin Green Jesse  
 Ross and Elizabeth Ross his wife Israel H. Brown and Nancy  
 M. Brown his wife have bargained and sold their respective  
 shares of the said three fifths of said land to Willis Mc Green  
 and whereas the said Willis Mc Green has released relinquished  
 and conveyed all his right title and interest in one hundred
