And upon receiving our interest or distribution shares of said Estates we hereby further authorize our said Attorney to execute and sign for us and in our respective names, such receipt or receipts deeds of conveyance or any other instrument that may be required under the Statutes and Laws of the State of South Carolina so as to fully discharge the person or persons having in charge our interest as aforesaid in said Estates from any future liabilities as the custodian of the same, hereby ratifying and confirming whatsoever our said attorney may do by virtue of these presents. The words shares in the 3^d line of this deed of attorney inserted before signing.
