Greenville District

This agreement made and entered
into this fourteenth day of September in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and sixty four between G. W. Hoff of said
District and State of the first part and A. H. Jenkins of said District
and State of the second part witnesseth, That the said G. W. Hoff
hath agreed and doth hereby agree to lease to the said A. H. Jenkins
all that lot of land and the improvements thereon containing
two acres more or less situate lying and being on the south side
of Bluncombe Street within the corporate limits of the town of
Greenville in the District and State aforesaid, and on which
the said A. H. Jenkins now resides, and which was conveyed
to the said G. W. Hoff by Joseph Glover Trustee of A. H. Jenkins
and Margaret Jenkins by deed of September 7th 1864, To hold
the said premises to the said A. H. Jenkins while and for so long
as he shall choose, to occupy the same himself during the exis-
tence of the present war between the Confederate States and
the United States, at and for the yearly sum and rent of six
hundred and thirty dollars, being the interest on the price
of the same, for each and every year and at the same rate
for any portion of a year, That the said A. H. Jenkins
may continue so to occupy the same, the said rent to be
paid yearly at the close of each year or at the end of said
term, if from any cause it shall cease before the end of a
