 paid by Marshall Shelton have granted bargained sold & conveyed and
 by these presents do grant bargain sell & convey unto the said Marshall
 Shelton all that Real and personal property which I received by my
 wife Eleanor Waldrop consisting of a tract of land containing One
 hundred & sixty acres more or less on which I am now living house
 hold & kitchen furniture their stock also all debts due my said wife
 to have & to hold all & singular the said land & other personal property
 whatsoever to the said Marshall Shelton his heirs Executors and adju-
 nitors forever, in trust for the sole & separate use of my wife Eleanor
 Waldrop during her life time with the right on the part of the
 said Eleanor Waldrop to give and dispose of the said land and
 personal property as she may see proper by will or deed or gift
 & at the death of the said Eleanor Waldrop, unless she does
 not dispose of the same in her lifetime then the whole real
 and personal property above mentioned to go & be divided am-
 ongst her heirs at law according to the Statutes of des-
 titutions in South Carolina, and I do hereby release & forever
 give up to the said Marshall Shelton all the property which
 I got by my said wife for the uses & trust above mentioned &
 do hereby authorize him to come & take the sum of I have
 used out of the said property I am to make it good & pay
 back the value of the same to the said Marshall Shelton in
 trust as aforesaid, And I forever relinquish all the right
 I might have in law to the property which my said wife may
 have after acquire or get possession of to the said Marshall
 Shelton in trust as aforesaid, And all this is done on the
 conditions that my said wife shall never claim or attempt
 to claim any property of mine which she did not bring to me
 on our marriage either in my life time or after my death
 And I do hereby bind myself to pay all the expenses & cost
 which have accrued in the prosecution commenced against
 me by the said Eleanor Waldrop for an assault & battery,
 and I hereby bind myself not to interfere with my said wife
 hereafter in any way whatsoever or claim her as a wife
