Gilbreath all that piece parcel and tract of land situate lying and being in the District and State aforesaid on the Spartamburg road adjoining lands of James M. Carter J. C. Waddell Mrs. Houghs E. J. Buist and others, Beginning at a stake 37 on the Spartamburg Road and running thence N 45 W 77 chs to a Post oak 37 thence S 20 W 12 chs to red oak 37 thence N 10 W 3.61 chs to a Post oak 37 thence down corner of Mrs. Houghs Tract then N 72 E 20 chs to a stake 37 thence N 77 E 55.83 chs to a Post oak 37 thence S 4 1/2 E 25.25 chs to a stake 37 thence S 1/2 E 6 chs to a fork white oak 37 thence S 26 E 10 chs to small white oak 37 at the Spartamburg Road thence S 57 W 8 chs to a stump by Blacksmith Shop thence same course 11.30 chs to a station thence
