 To S B Hutchings For Land Greenville District
 I know all men by these presents that I Thomas Log

Fowler Esuter of Elizabeth Fowler his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred & thirty two Dollars to me in hand paid by Samuel B Hutchings of the same State and Dist I have granted Bargained sold & released & do by these presents grant bargain sell and release unto the said Samuel B Hutchings & to his heirs & assigns forever a certain piece or parcel of land situate lying & being in the same State & Dist. aforesaid on both sides of the Long Branch of Rocky creek waters of Enoree River containing by late survey fifty four acres be the same more or less Beginning on Rock Creek at the mouth of the Long Branch & runs S 70 E 10 chains to a stone 3+ on wagon Road thence Southward with the meanders of said Road to a stone corner nearly opposite with the spring thence North 66 West 28 chains to a saplar 3+ on Branch 3+ new. thence down the meanders of said Branch about five chains to a maple 3+. thence N 25 E 4.40 to a white oak 3+ thence N 24 E 13 50 to a Dog wood 3+ thence N 41 E 6 chains to a gum 3+ on the said Rocky creek thence down meanders of the creek to mouth of said Long Branch the beginning which Bound contains the land to be conveyed. Together with all the rights member hood & appertinances & appurtenances thence unto belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. I have & to hold all and singular the above premises unto the said Samuel B Hutchings & his heirs & assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant & forever defend the above premises unto the said Samuel B Hutchings his heirs & assigns against myself my heirs & against every other person whatsoever claiming the same or any part thereof In witness I have thence unto set my hand & seal this 5th day of February 1861
