Greenville District in the State aforesaid in consideration of One Hundred and twenty dollars to me paid by Baylis Moon a person of color, of Greenville District in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Baylis Moon all that piece parcel and lot of land situate lying and being in the town of Greenville in the said District and State near the track of the Greenville and Columbia Rail Road, and adjoining lots of David McKenzie Polly Ann Burton Polly McCallan and Sally Morris and containing one half acres more or less being the same which was sold and conveyed by John W Brooks to Joseph Pigott and by him to me together with all and singular the rights menibus hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Baylis Moon his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Baylis Moon his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
