for and in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred and twenty eight
dollars and forty five cents to me in hand paid or caused to be paid by
Thomas W. Lee of the District of Greenville and State aforesaid have granted
bargained sold and remant and by these presents do grant bargain sell and
release unto the said Thomas W. Lee a certain piece parcel or tract of
Land containing One Thousand and Twenty two acres be the same more or
less situate in the State and District aforesaid on the East side of Reedy
River known as the John Shockley tract of Land, beginning at a stake 34
on on the road leading from the Benson old place to Reedy River church
thence along said road 485 6.828 chs to bend in said road thence N 33 E
6.00 chs to bend in road thence N 33 3/4 E 6.12 chains to bend in road thence
N 39 1/2 E 12.57 chs to bend in said road thence N 35 E 6.17 chs to bend in said
road thence N 33 3/4 E 5.92 chs to bend in road thence N 52 1/2 E 9.56 chs to Bend

and singular the said premises unto the said Thomas W. Lee his heirs and
assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever
lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
