 the said Ellen Howell is indebted to the said Margaret
 Walker in the sum of eight hundred dollars for which and
 she has given three seals the one given the 1st of August
 & payable the 1st of September 1866 for two hundred dollars and
 for three hundred dollars drawn on the 1st of August inst &
 payable one year after date and a third for three hundred
 dollars drawn on the 1st of August inst, and payable two
 years after date and where said notes were given for the pur-
 chase money of a lot of land hereinafter described and
 mortgaged Now this indebtedness witnesseth that the said
 Ellen Howell for and in consideration of the premises afore-
 said and also in consideration of the sum of three dollars
 to the said Ellen Howell by the said Margaret Walker
 in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these
 presents have granted bargained sold and released and by
 these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the
 said Margaret Walker all that piece parcel and lot of land
 containing seven thousand five hundred & sixty four square feet
 or less and situate being and being within the corporate limits
 of the Town of Greenville in the said State and upon the West
 side of the charleston & the south side of Coffey St. in the said
 Town and which is bounded as follows that is to say for sixty
 two feet on the East by Richardson St. aforesaid for one
 hundred & twenty four feet on the North by Coffey Street on
 the West for sixty two feet by a lot of land of my own when I
 now live and on the South one hundred & twenty two feet by the
 same lot as upon the West. these premises now mortgaged
 being a part of land conveyed by to the said Margaret
 Walker. Together with all and singular the rights member-
 ship and appurtenances to the said premises belonging
 or in anywise incident or appertaining, to have and to hold
 all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said
 Margaret Walker her heirs and assigns forever, and I
 do hereby bind my heirs executors and administrators
 to warrant and defend all and singular the said
 premises unto the said Margaret Walker her heirs and
 assigns against her and by her and against every
 person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same
 or any part thereof, Provided always nevertheless and
 it is the true intent and meaning of the parties to these
 presents that if the said Ellen Howell her heirs executors
 or administrators shall well and truly pay or cause to be
 paid unto the said Margaret Walker the sum of eight
 hundred dollars according to the sealed notes above

mentioned them and from thenceforth these presents shall be
 utterly null and void, anything herein contained to the contrary
 thereof in anywise notwithstanding, and it is covenanted and
 agreed upon by and between the parties to these presents that
 until default shall be made in payment of the aforesaid
 sum as before set forth, and the interest for the same it
 shall and may be lawful to and for the said Ellen Howell
 peaceably and quietly to hold use, occupy possess and
 enjoy all and singular the premises above granted and released
 and every part thereof with the appurtenances and to have
 receive and take the rents issues and profits thereof to her
 own particular use and behoof, anything herein contained to
 the contrary hereof in anywise notwithstanding.

 Cannon and applied to the payment of the said Note
