above mentioned and described. Together with the appurtenances  
unto the said Paschal D'Heuff his successors and assigns. In  
trust nevertheless for the use and benefit of my said two  
daughters (to) Sarah Ann Heuff and Cornelia Ellen Heuff  
for and during the terms of their natural lives free from the  
debts contracts habilities and obligations of any husband  
which either of them may have and at the death of either or both  
of my said daughters to her or their heirs fore and should either or both
