 furniture & stock of Negroes to have and to hold all and singular the
 property before mentioned unto the said Archibald Mitchell his
 heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs
 executors administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular
 the property aforesaid unto the said Archibald Mitchell his
 heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and against any
 other person claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
 The condition of the above obligation is such that if the said
 Seth M Pool shall pay to the said Archibald Mitchell a certain
 Note for the sum of One hundred fifty dollars with interest given
 in favor of Archibald Mitchell signed by Seth M Pool dated the
 7th day of December 1866 then the above obligation to be void or
 else to remain in full force and virtue and that on failure of the
 payment of the said Note then it shall be lawful and I do hereby
 authorize and direct the said Archibald Mitchell to buy and
 possess or sell so much of the said property as will satisfy & pay
 the said Note & interest together with the cost that may be created
