Henry in on the north and east by the Road being the same conveyed, together with the lot of (57) fifty nine acres above mentioned to the said John W Grady by Henry R Williams by Deed of 17 March 1863, together with the buildings improvements and fixtures and all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said James B Bivings and James S Bivings their heirs and assigns forever, and I the said John W Grady do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said James B Bivings and James S Bivings their heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and against every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, Provided always herewith, and it is the true intent and meaning of the parties to these presents that if the said John W Grady his heirs Executors or Administrators shall pay or cause to be paid unto the said James Bivings the sum of Ten thousand and five hundred Dollars and unto the said James S Bivings the sum of Nine thousand and five hundred dollars according to the sealed notes above mentioned then and from thenceforth these presents shall be utterly null and void anything herein contained to the contrary thereof in anywise notwithstanding, and it is covenanted and agreed upon by and between the parties to these presents that until default shall be made in the payment of the aforesaid sums as before set forth and the interest for the same it shall and may be lawful to and for the said John W Grady peaceably and quietly to hold use occupy and enjoy all and singular the premises above granted and released and any part thereof with the appurtenances, and to have receive and take the rents issues and profits thereof to his own particular use and behoof anything herein contained to the contrary thereof in anywise notwithstanding, and it is also agreed by and between the parties to these presents that the said John W Grady shall and will keep the buildings erected and to be erected on the lands above conveyed insured against loss and damage by fire by insurance, and in an amount approved by the said James Bivings and James S Bivings and assign the policy and certificate thereof to the said James Bivings and James S Bivings and in default thereof it shall be lawful for the said James Bivings and James S Bivings to effect such insurance and the premium and premiums paid for effecting the same shall be a lien upon the said mortgage premises added to the amount of said notes, and secured by these presents, and payable on demand with interest at the rate of seven per cent per annum.

Grady & Hawthorn vs J & S Bivings	351	The State of South Carolina This Indenture made the fourteenth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty six between John W Grady of Greenville District and David C Hawthorn of Abbeville District in said State of the one part, and James Bivings and James S Bivings of Spartanburg District in the State aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth whereas the said John W Grady and David C Hawthorn together with Sydney H Turleyfield are jointly indebted to the said James Bivings and James S Bivings in the sum of Twenty thousand Dollars \$20,000. To wit to the said James Bivings in the sum of Ten thousand Five hundred Dollars \$10,500 by ten joint and several sealed Notes bearing even date with these presents with interest from date to be paid or computed annually, Five of said Notes being for one thousand dollars each, and due and payable as follows, the first six months after date the next six months after the first and so on every succeeding six months till the last which is given for fifteen hundred dollars and payable five years from date, and to the said James S Bivings in the sum of Nine thousand and Five hundred dollars \$9,500 by ten joint and several sealed notes of even date with these presents with interest from date to be paid or computed annually, Five of said Notes being for one thousand dollars each and due and payable as follows, to wit, the first six months after date the next six months after the first and so on every six months till the last and tenth which is given for five hundred dollars and payable five years after date, the said notes to the said James Bivings and the said notes to the said James S Bivings having been given by the said John W Grady David C Hawthorn and Sydney H Turleyfield jointly and severally for the respective interests and proportional amounts and shall of the said James Bivings and James S Bivings in and of the said twenty thousand dollars \$20,000 being the purchase money or consideration for a tract of land supposed to contain three hundred and sixty acres situate on Middle Tyger river in Spartanburg District in said State in which is a cotton factory and machinery a mill dwelling and other improvements.
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
