and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said
Henry Bonnemeyer all that Lot of land situated in the Town of Green-
ville District & State aforesaid commencing at a Stake on the south
side of Main Crop Street sixty feet south East from the corner of
Main & Rail street running thence with the line back Main crop street
572 ft & fifty six feet to a Stake corner of adjoining enclosure. Then N 77°
W Eighty five and one half feet to a Stake on the cross fence thence
N 72° 40' W along the fence fifty six feet to a Stake thence N 77° 40' E along the
line dividing the premises from the corner lot eighty five and one half feet to the
beginning corner bounded on the N.E. by Main Crop Street you all
other sides by lots of 30' Grady being part of a lot sold by G. S.

is indebted to the said George F. Lownes in the sum of two thousand
and fifty Dollars by note payable to the said George F. Lownes or order
in one and two years equal installments with interest from date pay-
able annually, as by appearance will then fully appear. Now this indenture
witnesseth that the said Henry Bonnemeyer for and in consideration
of the premises aforesaid and also in consideration of the sum of five dollars
to the said Henry Bonnemeyer by the said George F. Lownes in hand paid
at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents have granted, re-
served, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain and
