McPee and And the cause being at issue before the Honorable Court came on to be heard at July term in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty seven when the said Court after full hearing thereof and mature deliberation in the premises did order, Adjudge, and Decree that a certain portion of the real estate of Vardry McPee deceased as recommended by the Commissioners in Partition should be conveyed by the Commissioners of the said Court on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in their Decretal order as by reference thereto in the registry of the said Court will appear to Vardry A. McPee now, therefore this indenture witnessed that the said Jas. P.
