Sell and Release unto the said Alexander McBe his
Heirs and Assigns Four hundred and fifty acres of
what is known and described in the tract of partition
and the return of the Commissioners as the same
place and as tract No 18 containing one thousand and
fourty acres more or less and more particular
ly described in the plat of the same annexed
hereto together with all and singular the hereditaments
rights members Appurtenances whatever to the said
land belonging or in anywise appertaining and the
Reversions and Remainders rents leases and Profits
thereof and also all the Estate Right Title Interest
Power Possession Property Benefit Claim and Demand
whatsoever both at Law and in Equity of the Heirs
and Representatives of the said Vandy McBe deceased
and of the parties to this suit and of all other persons
rightfully claiming or to claim the same or any part
thereof by force or under them or either of them to have
