This indenture made the 10th day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty seven between Abraham Collins of Greenville District of the one part and Isaac Winfield of the other part witnesses the said Abraham Collins stands indebted to the said Isaac Winfield in the full and just sum of four hundred and thirty Dollars by two several notes one payable twelve months after date with interest from date for the sum of two hundred and two Dollars one dated the 10th day of December eighteen hundred and sixty seven and other note payable two years after date with interest from date for the sum of two hundred and ten Dollars and dated fourth December eighteen hundred and sixty seven referred to said notes will more fully appear. Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said Abraham Collins for and in consideration of the said debts or sums payable as aforesaid and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Isaac Winfield according to the tenor of the two several notes above and also in consideration of the sum of five Dollars by the said Isaac Winfield to the said Abraham Collins in hand paid and before the sealing and delivery of these presents do grant bargain sell release convey and confirm unto the said Isaac Winfield and to his heirs and assigns forever all that piece parcel and tract of land situated in Greenville District Beginning at a stake 34 the McClellan Road running Thence N 25 3/4 W 17.50 to a Spanish oak 3 oak young Thence S 88 3/4 W 52.13 to a P.O. 34 Thence S 40 W 10 to a stone 34 Thence the State Road to a stake 34 Thence W 10.25 to a stake 34 Thence to a P.O. 34 on the McClellan Road Thence down the McClellan Road to the beginning bounded by lands of Elijah Hill Thomas Chandler referred to a Plat Surveyed by J. H. Patton D. 9. 31st Oct. 1867 will more fully appear and by reference to a deed made to Abraham Collins by Isaac Winfield and bearing date with these presents will also appear and containing Eighty four Acres more or less together with all and singular the rights member hereof and appertaining thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining and the remainder and residue thereof remain due and unpaid unto Isaac Winfield and profits thereof to have and to hold the said piece parcel and tract of land with the appertaining unto the said Isaac Winfield his heirs and assigns forever provided always nevertheless and it is the true intent and meaning of the parties that if the said Abraham Collins his heirs Executors or Administrators shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Isaac Winfield
