grant bargain sell and release unto the said John M. Brotowell

ing one hundred and fifty acres more or less situate
lying and being in the said District and State on both
sides of the State Roads and the Rutherford Road at
the crossing of the said Road, being that portion of the
W. McKay tract, conveyed to us by Mr. McKay by deed of
even date with these presents. Beginning at a post oak
84 mms and running thence N 36 W 28ch to a Chestnut stump
thence N 28 E W 28.80 ch to a Red Oak tree 84 mms E
18ch to a State Thence S 14 W 32.40 to a State Thence N 62.4 W 5ch to a
State Thence S 39. 37 mches to the beginning corner the lines
