State aforesaid together with all and singular the  
rights, franchises, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said  
premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to  
have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned  
unto the said Hamlin Beattie, William Beattie, William  
Holland, Charles Boyley, Peter F. Suddith and William Cox  
their heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind  
myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and  
forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the  
said Hamlin Beattie, William Beattie, William Holland, Charles  
Boyley, Peter F. Suddith and William Cox their heirs and  
assigns against myself and my heirs and against  
every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim  
the same or any part thereof. Provided always notwithstanding  
and it is the true intent and meaning of the parties to  
these presents that if the said James St. Germany his heirs  
executors or administrators shall will and truly pay or  
cause to be paid unto the said Hamlin Beattie, William  
Beattie, William Holland and Charles Boyley Peter F. Suddith  
and William Cox the respective sums above mentioned  
according to the tenor and effect of the said  
several promissory notes above described, then and there  
for the same shall be null and void any thing herein  
contained to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding  
standing. And it is covenanted and agreed upon by the  
parties to these presents that until default shall be made  
in payment of the aforesaid sum as before defined it shall  
and may be lawful to and for the said James St. Germany  
peaceably and quietly to hold, have, occupy, possess and enjoy  
all and singular the premises above granted and released  
and every part thereof with the appurtenances unto  
have and receive the rents and profits thereof to his own
