of fifteen thousand dollars to me paid by John Clinck Jr of the City of  
Charleston in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and  
by these presents do grant, Bargain sell and release unto the said John  
Clinck Jr all that piece, parcel and tract of Land containing One  
hundred and forty four acres more or less situate lying and being in the  
District of Greenville in the State aforesaid, about nine miles west from  
Greenville Court House upon the White Horse and Pendleton Roads and  
upon the waters of Saluda River adjoining lands of Hobk Towns Pointett  
Cleveland and Brush and having the following lines poles and bounds  
according to a plat made by John Watson D. S. attached to a deed of the  
said premises from Whiteford Smith to the said Robert Stewart viz  
Beginning at a Stake 3+ n on the Pendleton Road and running hence N. with  
the said road to a bend. Hence with said road N 60 W 1/2 chains to ab 0.3407  
a. Stake 3+ n thence S 56 W 24 chains to a Pine Knob 3+ thence S 56 E 31 chains to a S  
0.340 thence N 75 E 23 chains to a Pine 3+ 0 thence S 30 E 7 chain to a B. P. 3+ 0 thence  
N 3. E 17.25 to a Stake 3+ 0 at white Horse road thence N 70 E 28.45 to the beginning  
corner. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments  
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident  
or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned

myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all

To So 16<sup>th</sup> This I do declare the twenty-seventh  
of A. D. 1863 lot of day of July in the year of our Lord one  
thousand eight hundred and sixtynine  
eight between James P. Moore Esq. Commissioner of the  
Honorable Court of Equity for Greenville District of Greenville  
The Court House in the said State of the said part and  
Dr Augustus D. Clarke of the other part, Whereas James P.  
Moore Administrator of W. A. McCowne deceased  
on or about the Eighteenth day of October in the year of our  
Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixtynine exhi-  
bited his bill of complaint in the Court of Equity at  
Greenville Court House in the said State against the  
A. W. McCowne et al, And the cause being at issue  
before the Honorable Court and now to be heard at  
Chambers in the year of our Lord one thousand eight  
hundred and sixtynine where the said Court after  
full hearing thereof and mature deliberation in the  
premises did Order Adjudged and Decreed that the  
real Estate of William A. McCowne as described in  
the Bill - Should be sold at public Auction by the law  
minister of the said Court on the terms and for the  
purposes mentioned in their Decided Order as by before  
enumerated in the Registry of the said Court will appear  
And the said James P. Moore Esq. as Commissioner  
the said Court after having duly advertised the said  
Land for sale by Public outcry on the first Monday  
of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight  
hundred and sixtynine and sixtynine did then openly and  
publicly and accordingly to the custom of Auctions  
sell and dispose of the said lot of Land above de-  
scribed unto the said Dr Augustus D. Clarke for Two Thousand  
and fifty Dollars the being at that price the highest  
bidder for the same. Now therefore This Indenture witness  
etc. That the said James P. Moore Esq. as Commissioner  
of the said Court minister and by virtue of the said  
Decree and in Consideration of the sum of Two Dollars  
paid him by the said Dr. A. D. Clarke the Receipt whereof is  
hereby acknowledged and hath received a Bargain and Sale &  
Released and by this Deed to the said Dr. A. D. Clarke his  
Heirs and Assigns all that tract or lot of Land situated  
lying and lying in the Town of Greenville Dis-  
trict of Greenville and State aforesaid delineate
